September 26-October 1, 2020

Day 1 Fly to Boston (D)

Board your flight for a journey to discover the roots of our country in Boston, MA. This trip is filled with historic sites and attractions that embody the democracy we enjoy today. Upon arrival meet your local guide that will be with you the entire trip. Enjoy dinner with your fellow Shrine travel mates. **Overnight (5), Boston area, MA**

Day 2 Historic Boston Tour/Quincy Market/USS Constitution (B, D)

Today tour the one of the oldest cities in the United States. As the largest city in New England, Boston is regarded as the unofficial "Capital of New England" for its economic and cultural impact on the entire New England region. Your guide will point out sights along the Freedom Trail as well as the Boston Common and Public Gardens, the Back Bay, Beacon Hill, and the gold-domed State House.

A visit inside **OLD NORTH CHURCH** is a treat. This is the site where the signal was given to Paul Revere warning that the British were marching upon Lexington and Concord. Built in 1723, the Old North Church is a step back into colonial times. Then, visit Paul Revere's house and enjoy captivating exhibits on Revere's ride and his business ventures; a museum shop and more.

Have lunch at **QUINCY MARKET**. For over 250 years it has played an integral role in the life of Boston's residents. Take time to visit **FANEUIL HALL**, which served as a meeting hall during colonial times. This afternoon continue your Boston tour and visit the **CHARLESTOWN NAVY YARD** home to the **USS CONSTITUTION**, otherwise known as **OLD IRONSIDES**, the oldest commissioned ship in the U.S. Navy. Enjoy dinner with your travel mates.

Day 3 JFK Library & Museum/Shriner's Hospital for Children/Boston Tea Party Ship (B, L, D)

The museum at the Kennedy Library

captures the powerful story of the Kennedy years, giving visitors of all ages an uplifting, first-hand experience of president Kennedy's life, leadership and legacy. Next, tour the **SHRINERS HOSPITAL FOR CHILDREN** in Boston and see how they serve the children in the area with special needs. Lunch is included at the hospital.

Step again back in time with a colonial character who will guide you through the **BOSTON TEA PARTY SHIPS & MUSEUM**. The museum features full-scale replicas, artifacts and interactive elements of this historic event. Meet Sam Adams and participate in the re-enactment of the destruction of the tea. Board a tall ship and marvel at one of only two known surviving tea crates. Have dinner again with your travel mates and discuss the interesting sights of the day.

Day 4 House of Seven Gables/Salem Witch Museum/Witchcraft and Ghost Experience/Witch Dungeon Museum (B, D)

Tour the **HOUSE OF SEVEN GABLES**. This home inspired author Nathaniel Hawthorne to write his famous novel **The House of Seven Gables**. Then, visit **SALEM WITCH MUSEUM**. Witness the testimony of the hysterical girls, the suffering of the blameless victims, and the decisions of the fanatical judges who sent innocent people to their deaths. This presentation is based on actual trial documents. With 13 stage sets, you'll enter the web of lies and intrigue of the Salem Witch Hunt, one of the most enduring true stories in American History. In keeping with the theme, see the **WITCH CRAFT AND GHOST EXPERIENCE**. It's an incredible mix of special effects, actors, costumes, story-telling, diversions, exhilarating experiences, surprises, jump scares, all blended with historical facts about the **SALEM WITCH TRIALS**. And finally,

tour the **WITCH DUNGEON MUSEUM**. It's an award winning reenactment of the trial of beggar-woman Sarah Good . from the original transcript of 1692. Dare if you will to enjoy dinner together after a %ightful+day of sightseeing.

Day 5 Plymouth Rock/Mayflower 2/Pliimoth Plantation/ Pilgrim Hall Museum/Jenney Grist Mill/Traditional Turkey Dinner at Pliimoth Plantation (B, D)

In 2020, Massachusetts will hold a year-long commemoration of the 400th anniversary of the Mayflower voyage and the founding of Plymouth Colony-America's Hometown. See Forefather's Monument, the largest solid granite monument in the U.S. A picture stop will also be made at the Plymouth Rock, the traditional site of disembarkation of the Pilgrims in 1620 and the Mayflower 2. Visit the Jenney Grist Mill; it tells the story of the grist (corn grinding) mill built by the Pilgrims in Plymouth Colony. Visit the **PILGRIM HALL MUSEUM** that houses an unmatched collection of Pilgrim possessions. Then head over to the **PLIMOTH PLANTATION** (yes, this is spelled correctly); be a part of a replica of the original Pliimoth Plantation and learn about the lifestyle in the 1620's by observing pilgrims at work and at home. Make sure you speak to the %pilgrims+ you meet. *Remember they know nothing about events after 1627!* A **TRADITIONAL TURKEY DINNER** at **PLIMOTH PLANTATION** awaits with a menu that will make your mouth water.

Day 6 Sam Adams Brewery Tour/Fly Home (B)

This morning visit the **SAM ADAMS BREWERY**. Boston Beer founder Jim Koch is the sixth generation of Koch brew masters and the sixth oldest son to be lured by the smell of hops and the desire to make great beer. On the tour you will get the history of the well-known Sam Adams Brewery %pilot plant+. Then it's time to head to the airport for your flight home. Recall all the wonderful memories shared with fellow Shrine friends.
