



# Twin Cities Ambulatory Care Clinic Update

Greetings to all and with hope you had a fabulous holiday season!

Here we are at the start of 2023 and I can't be more excited for the **Twin Cities Ambulatory Care Clinic**. We had a fairly successful year in 2022 establishing a number of things to help position our site in the market and increase service offerings. This includes installing sensory space equipment in Rehab Therapy, being approved for direct community referrals for rehab, developing cranial facial offerings for plagiocephaly and torticollis along with gaining approval of our 2023 strategic plan, budget and specific initiatives to develop further affiliated partnerships.

Foundationally, while all of these are necessary and exciting we have a few more things to do in 2023 if we want to be relevant and serve our market. But for now, the bigger challenge is to grow our numbers of patient visits in each of our service lines, clinic, therapy, POPS, imaging and surgeries. Having these resources is great but without the patients these along with staff sit idle. This is going take each of us spreading the word and promoting the name more than we have likely ever done and in ways that are not necessarily familiar to Shriners Children's.



## **MEMORIES**

The Black Camel has visited the Sesostris Corvettes once again. Noble Don Love passed and he is greatly missed. When we waited for a parade to start, Don always worked right up to parade step-off time to polish his Vette to the perfect form. He was a real friend to all of us in the unit and his warm smile is a wonderful memory.



### From his Obituary are the following comments:



"For Don, life was too short to drive slow cars. He treasured his Corvettes and didn't hesitate to share this joy, often putting new drivers in the family behind the wheel of his baby. He enjoyed the friendship and camaraderie of other enthusiasts in Lincoln's Corvette Club, participating in car shows and parades across the state."

"Don loved to fly. It was both his passion and his career. He often recounted the Army National Guard as a life-defining good fortune, joining September 2, 1953, when he was just 17 (and weighing 119 lbs. soaking wet). He entered service as a Private First Class and airplane mechanic. He became a helicopter pilot on April 15, 1969, and a Chief Warrant Officer 4, May 9, 1983. Don entered active duty and was deployed to Desert Storm, returning when he was 55-years old. In total, Don dedicated 42 years, 8 months and 28 days to the service of his country and the State of Nebraska."

In the 12 years that I have been in the unit, we have lost five men to the Black Camel: Jack Mills, Larry Lewis, Arvid Barth, Jerry Ritchie and Don Love. In addition, some have left the state: Al Klassmeyer and Bob Simard. Our snow birds are only gone half the year. A couple others have joined different units, so our unit is in need of new blood for sure!

- All trees must be new artificial trees in the original box. (Shrine Center will keep new box)
- All lighting on trees or décor must be new of LED type and with Underwriters Lab label.
- Original <u>retail</u> value of Sponsor's package must be \$500.00 minimum (tree, lights, ornaments and gifts) and should be itemized when delivered to Sesostris Shrine Center.
- Trees should be between 60" and 96" tall and of any diameter.
- Designated tree display space for each sponsor will 72"x 72". Any other space options must be approved by the FEZtival Director.
- Trees must be secured for free standing. A good solid stand will provide the best stability.
- A skirting or stand covered with cotton batting is recommended. Items placed at the bottom or on the skirting will considered part of the tree and will be given away as part of the raffle winner's tree.

Get ready for the 149th Imperial Session of Shriners International, July 2-6, 2023 in Charlotte, North Carolina, All nobles, ladies and their families are invited to join Imperial Sir Kenny Craven and Lady JJ for the fraternity's biggest event of the year.

### **ENJOY "THE QUEEN CITY!"**

Charlotte, known for its Southern charm and tradition, has had an interesting history from the start. The city, one of the fastest growing in the nation, was named after Queen Charlotte, the queen consort of British King George III, when the city was founded in 1768. While it was named after the queen and nicknamed "The Queen City," Charlotte was the first governmental body in America to declare itself independent from the Crown.

### **EXPLORE CHARLOTTE**

For family fun, there's one place to start: the NASCAR Hall of Fame. First, it's attached to the convention center by a walkway. Second, it's NASCAR! Maybe you'd like to try NASCAR racing for yourself on the racing simulator that lets you experience what it feels like racing on NASCAR tracks. Your simulation is broadcast on a 15-foot overhead video screen. You'll also get the feel of the big races in the 278-seat High Octane Theater where you get to see NASCAR's history – from Daytona Beach to the present day – projected on a 64-foot screen with surround sound. Check it out at nascarhall.com.

Just 13 miles from the convention center, you'll find Carowinds amusement park, with nearly 60 world-class rides, including fourteen roller coasters with thrill levels ranging from kiddie to crazy. There is also Camp Snoopy, which is filled with rides for the little ones. The park's Carolina Harbor claims its place as the best

waterpark in the Carolinas, with everything from Blackbeard's Revenge to Kiddy Hawk Cove. Visit carowinds.com.

For those interested in an inspirational experience, visit the Billy Graham Library. This museum and library documents and commemorates the life and ministry of Billy Graham. It looks like a barn, reminiscent of the farm where Graham was raised. The exhibit even has an animated, talking cow to welcome visitors, and profiles Graham, his wife, his ministry and his impact. Graham and his wife are buried in the prayer garden at the library.

If you and your family are looking for adventure and an adrenaline blast, head to the U.S. National Whitewater Center, about 16 miles from the convention center. Here you can raft the world's largest manmade whitewater river, testing rapids from class II to IV with a professional guide. Decide between family rafting, adventure rafting, "big water" sessions (where the water flow is twice as much and twice as intense), or even "rodeo rafting" on a smaller raft. You can also try ziplines, rope courses, climbing, flat-water kayaking, yoga and more. Visit center. whitewater.org for a preview.

Charlotte Convention Center Imperial Session will take place in the convention center, located in the middle of everything! The public opening, pageant, marketing and communications report, All Nobility Evening and business sessions will be held in the 40,000 square-foot Crown Ballroom. The center is steps away from attractions, every kind of food and fanfare, and nightlife. It is located seven miles from Charlotte Douglas International Airport.

### WE HOPE TO SEE YOU THERE

The 2023 Imperial Session will be one of fun, fellowship and celebration. Imperial Sir Kenny Craven, Lady JJ and Oasis Shriners look forward to hosting our nobles, families and friends in Charlotte. # **MEMBERSHIP INCENTIVES PROGRAM REVISED**

Effective January 1, 2023

- 1. Each line signer, in good standing, will receive one point for a new petition. a restoration or an affiliation.
- 2. After a Noble attains five points, he will receive a membership medallion with a red, green and yellow ribbon. For each succeeding five petitions, he will receive a diamond in his membership medallion for a maximum of five diamonds. Once he has been a line signer for 35 petitions, he will receive a gold ribbon to wear with his membership medallion.
- 3. Each TOP LINE SIGNER who is a line signer for TWO Nobles in any given calendar year will be eligible to receive a 2023 parade shirt (various colors available) with embroidered emblem and name of Shriner.
- 4. Each TOP LINE SIGNER who is a line signer for FIVE Nobles in any given calendar year will be eligible to have his Sesostris Shrine dues paid for the next calendar year.
- 5. Line signers, if they desire, may place the Fez on their new Noble during the fezzing ceremony.
