

JOHN D. VERMAAS

Imperial Potentate 1996–1997 Shriners International August 3, 1937 – February 19, 2023



To the Representatives of Shriners International, Potentates of Temples and the Nobility of the Order:

He walked through life and left his impress there; He still lives on in ways we cannot know. His love of life and living is not lost; His spirit carries on in those he loved, And reaches out to touch humanity. A heritage continuing through the years.

John D. VerMaas, who served as Imperial Potentate of Shriners International, 1996–1997, passed away on February 19, 2023.

VerMaas was born on August 3, 1937, to Christian Leonard and Alpha Mary (Birt) VerMaas in Hickman, Nebraska. He founded the now three-generation construction firm, VerMaas Construction, Inc. in 1958. What began as a house-framing business, eventually evolved into home building and commerical general contracting, including for the Federal Government. He built and leased his first U.S. postal facility in Waverly, Nebraska, in 1968. VerMaas was a Past President of the Lincoln Home Builders Association, Nebraska State Home Builders Association and Past Director for the National Assocation of Home Builders.

Imperial Sir VerMaas was raised a Master Mason at Hickman Lodge #256 in 1959, serving as Worshipful Master in 1965 and again in 1971. He was a Scottish Rite Mason, earning his 32° in 1962, with investiture as 32° Knight Commander of the Court of Honor (KCCH) in 1977. He served as Venerable Master of the Lodge of Perfection in 1979 and was coronated with the 33° in 1985. He also received the Red Cross of Constantine.

VerMaas became a member of Sesostris Shriners in Lincoln, Nebraska, in 1962, serving as Potentate in 1984. He loved being a member of the Sesostris Motor Corps, participating in countless small-town parades in dozens of communities in southeast Nebraska. He was a principal founder of the Harley 74 Motorcycle Drill Team, which annually finished as one of the top parade units in the Central States and National Drill Competitions.

Imperial Sir VerMaas was elected as Imperial Outer Guard in 1986 and served as Imperial Potentate of Shriners International in 1996-1997. He went on to serve as Chairman of the Board of Trustees of Shriners Childrens from 1997-2003, becoming Chairman Emeritus in 2009. He was an active member of several Imperial-level committees including: Athletic, Audit, Budget, Building and Equipment, Insurance, Investment, Memership, Public Relations, Research and Salaries and Personnel. VerMaas made membership an important part of his fraternal experience, bringing in many new members to the Shrine.

He was preceded in death by his parents; wife, Marilyn (Ziemann); wife, Janice (Zwiebel); brother Virgil; sisters Letha Clement, Viva Craig, Evelyn Birrell; and step-daughter and husband Jeri (Dan) Reimnitz.

The Colorado Keys will be back next year on April 5 & 6, 2024!


















Spring is finally here and the Iron Nobles are ready to get back on two wheels.

Twin Cities Update

One hundred years and still going strong. In March, the Twin Cities Clinic celebrated 100 years of providing the best quality of care to children of all ages.

Polio was one of the most common illnesses treated at the Twin Cities hospital in the beginning. Over the years, with medical advancements, polio in the US has been mostly eradicated. Today, Shriners Children in the Twin Cities, help children with many different orthopedic challenges including brittle bone disease, club foot, limb deficiency, spina bifida, and scoliosis, just to name a few. Many of the conditions we treat today do not require overnight stays which has allowed us to downsize the facilities we need to take care of the kids. What hasn't changed, is the staff. Shriners Children continues to provide excellent pediatric care for the children.

Over the last couple of years, with many of the patients not needing overnight care, Twin Cities has started branching out to other locations, making it easier for the kids to be seen. Boys Town Children's Hospital is a great example of us going to the kids. Plus, we are continually visiting and looking at other locations for more outreach sites.

One of the outreach activities that the Clinic used to do regularly were screening clinics. COVID put a stop to the screening clinics. Lincoln is very fortunate that Dr. Samani has continued screening local children at his office once a month. It has been quite some time since a screening clinic has been held elsewhere in Nebraska. Now that COVID is over, the Blue Valley Shrine Club is exploring the possibility of hosting a screening clinic in Beatrice, with the goal of reaching out to the surrounding communities to see if there are kids who could benefit from the specialty care that Shriners can provide.

Over the years, Sesostris has been blessed to have one of the most active Road Runner Units in the Midwest. The drivers we have are truly committed to the mission of the Shriners. Many times, they drive the patient and a parent to the Clinic the day before their appointment, stay the night, and then bring them home after their appointment the next day. Some appointments might be in Omaha at Boys Town, and oftentimes, they deliver and pick up patients at the airport in Omaha who may have been at one of our other specialty care facilities like one of our burn care locations. Being a Road Runner is the one unit where a Shriner can truly be a Shriner. If you have any thoughts or questions about being a Road Runner, please reach out Eldon Ogorzolka. I'm sure he can encourage you to join them.


I want to acknowledge and recognize Cindy Lehn. Cindy is the hospital coordinator for Sesostris. Cindy is becoming the role model for hospital coordinators for the Twin Cities Clinic. She has been instrumental in creating and sharing her protocols with the other temples with the purpose of defining what a hospital coordinator's duties should be. Cindy has been working very closely with the staff in Woodbury and she has definitely earned their respect. 



MEMBERSHIP INCENTIVES PROGRAM REVISED

Effective January 1, 2023

- 1. Each line signer, in good standing, will receive one point for a new petition. a restoration or an affiliation.
- 2. After a Noble attains five points, he will receive a membership medallion with a red, green and yellow ribbon. For each succeeding five petitions, he will receive a diamond in his membership medallion for a maximum of five diamonds. Once he has been a line signer for 35 petitions, he will receive a gold ribbon to wear with his membership medallion.
- 3. Each TOP LINE SIGNER who is a line signer for TWO Nobles in any given calendar year will be eligible to receive a 2023 parade shirt (various colors available) with embroidered emblem and name of Shriner.
- 4. Each TOP LINE SIGNER who is a line signer for FIVE Nobles in any given calendar year will be eligible to have his Sesostris Shrine dues paid for the next calendar year.
- 5. Line signers, if they desire, may place the Fez on their new Noble during the fezzing ceremony.
